As teachers, they were able to come up with systems that made learning easier for the students based on their habits and needs. Currently, a Learning Management System like Quipper came up to help organize the teaching-learning process. They are not only to aid teachers in delivering e-lessons but also for the students to access information anytime, anywhere, and to make learning more enjoyable for them.

Quipper has a platform for the students called **Q-Learn**. Using this platform, students can access their teacher's lessons on any device, and they can study at their own pace. Also, it is easier for them to find relevant topics and answer their assignments in just one click.







Ways to access Q-Learn

Students can access the Q-Learn platform by following these steps:

1. Go to learn.quipper.com



- 2. Log-in using the username and password given during student orientation
- 3. Then, click 'Log-in'
- 4. If the student doesn't have an account yet, click 'Create an account'.

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To create an account, follow this procedure:

- 1. Fill out the required fields
- 2. Tick 'I have a School Membership Number' and enter the 12-digit number
- 3. Click 'Create Account'

Note: School Membership Number is a unique 12-digit code used to join a school organization. Without this code, the students won't be able to join their teacher's class and receive the assignments. Quipper Support Officers are in charge of distributing the membership number before or during the student orientation.

1. To access it, click the profile at the above right corner and click Q-Learn. A new window will automatically open.

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Parts and Features of Q-Learn

Q-Learn consists of 'Global Navigation Bar Menu', which are the main features of the platform.





This page serves as a student's Dashboard and shows all the active To-do items, My courses, and Class Activities.

The '**To-Do List**' tab shows the current assignments that the student needs to accomplish. If the student has more than six assignments, the six with the nearest





due dates will appear on the home page. The overdue to-do activities do not reflect here.



'**My Courses**' section shows the current bookmarked courses, and it organizes the topics that the student would like to study.



The '**Class Activities**' shows the current activities of other students in the class they've joined. This section serves as motivation for them to complete their pending tasks. Also, the Quipper Coordinator or Administrator in the school can disable this if it encourages unhealthy competition.

This tab shows all the courses that were enabled for the self-study of the students.

- 1. Students can browse all the courses using the drop-down menu and choosing a course set.
- 2. They can also bookmark the courses by clicking the ribbon beside the course description. Bookmarked courses will appear in the 'My Courses' tab.
- 3. Then to see the topics, click the course title.



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- 4. This part shows the learning progress of students and how many topics they have accomplished.
- 5. These are all the units and topics under the course set. Students can also see the progress in each topic.
- 6. Aside from the ribbon, they can also bookmark the courses using the 'Add to my courses' button.





This tab shows all the active to-dos, overdue, and completed activities.

'Active To-dos' shows all the active assignments arranged in the nearest due date.





'**Overdue**' shows all overdue assignments. Students can still answer it but will be tagged as late.



'**Completed**' shows all completed assignments. A yellow circle with a crown indicates that the student has mastered the assignment.





This tab shows all the messages that the student sent to his/her teachers.

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Note: Students cannot message his/her other classmates to avoid cheating and unnecessary conversations.



This tab shows all the bookmarked courses from the 'Course List'. This feature is also accessible on the 'Home' page.



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this tab will enable the students to update their profile, join a class, input membership number, and log-out their account.

To update their profile, click 'Edit'. Students can upload their profile picture, change username or password, update grade level, and input phone number.

How to Answer Assessment

To access the assignment, the student should click the assignment title on the 'Homepage' or 'To-Do' tab. This will show the topics included in that assignment together with the class name and type of assessment.



Each topic consists of a topic pane, which shows the progress of text lessons, video lessons, and quiz. Checkmark indicates that the students completed the specific lesson slide. On the right side of the topic pane is the learning view, which shows the video lessons or text lessons. Students have the option to download or read the study guide while viewing the video lessons through the learning view.

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Students can also:

- 1. Rate the topic
- 2. Download the study guide
- 3. Adjust the learning view depending on their reading preference
- 4. Open the study guide in a new tab
- 5. Zoom in or out for a clearer view of the study guide





In the previous lessons, different types of assessments in Quipper were discussed. To further understand each type, this is the actual format in the student's point of view.

Assignment

- students can access the lesson chapter, download study guide, and answer the assessment
- students can retake the assessment until they mastered the topic
- students can see if they got the correct or wrong answer



Examination

- students won't have access to the lesson chapter and study guide
- students can only answer the assessment once
- students will not see if they got the correct or wrong answer
- students cannot retry the assessment and master the topic

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Quiz & Review

- students will see the assessment first. If they got below 100%, that's the time they will have access to the lesson chapter and download the study guide.
- students can see if they got the correct or wrong answer
- students can retake the assessment until they mastered the topic

Parents are so-called first teachers, and they have a significant role in the development of their child's characteristics and learning process. Since they know their child better than the teachers, parents should also be responsible for overseeing their activities at school, help them with assignments, prepare them for exams, and reward them for doing a great job. On the other hand, teachers should also inform the parents about their children's accomplishments and areas for improvements. Various research shows that an active partnership between parents, family, teachers, school, and community leads to positive and improved learning outcomes for learners.

Fortunately, there's a portal in Quipper that parents can maximize to monitor their child's performance at school, and this is called the '**Parent's App**'.

Please take note that the account details of the student are given during orientation. In case the student forgot their username and password, the parents can ask the advisers for a copy.

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Once the parent successfully added their child in the Parents App, they will be able to see the following details:

- 1. Student's name
- 2. Last log in date of the student
- 3. Overview of the student's performance in 30 days
- 4. Active assignments of the student that shows the deadline, title, and number of topics.

An overview of the student's performance consists of 'Average Submission Rate', 'Average Score', and 'Mastered Topics Rate'.

'Average Submission Rate' measures the frequency of the students submitting their assignments on time. Then, the 'Average Score' measures the average

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first-time score of all the assignments that students received in 30 days. Lastly, the '**Mastered Topics Rate**' is the percentage of all assignments that scored 100%.

By checking the Parents' App regularly, they would be able to determine if their child has pending assignments, if they're consistent in answering it on time, or how many topics they already mastered. Parents can make the necessary interventions at home like reviewing difficult subjects and topics or assisting them in answering their assignments. This kind of participation from the parents will not only strengthen their relationship but also enhance the student's learning outcome.

Other function of the Parent's App

The parents can update their profile and change their password by following this procedure:

- 1. Click the profile name at the top right corner of the page
- 2. Update the account details
- 3. Once done, click 'Save'

Troubleshooting is a systematic approach to problem-solving that is often used to find and correct issues with complex machines, electronics, computers, and software systems. Since the Quipper platforms like Q-Link, Q-Learn, and Q-Create are kinds of application software, technical issues are inevitable.

This lesson will help determine how to troubleshoot common concerns encountered in the Quipper platforms. Also, this will guide the teachers, particularly technology immigrants, to navigate the platform smoothly and become an expert in using a Learning Management System like Quipper.





Troubleshooting common issues in the Quipper platforms are categorized into three, which are: Q-Link, Q-Learn, and Q-Create.

Q-Link FAQs

A. How to reset the student's password?

- 1. Go to the 'Students' tab
- 2. Type the student's name
- 3. Click '**Search**'
- 4. Click 'Settings'
- 5. Choose 'Change Password'
- 6. Type the new password by following the criteria
- 7. Click 'Change Password'
- 8. Give the new password to the student

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D. Why can the student not join a class?

Reasons:

- Students are using the wrong Q-Learn account. They tend to create a new account every time they forgot their password, not considering the importance of School Membership Number. To check if they're using the right account, follow the procedure in FAQ-A. Their username can also be viewed here, give it to the student and tell them to use this account only. There is also an option to manually add the student to the class by following the procedure in FAQ-C.
- Students are encoding a wrong class code. Please take note that class codes consist of 7 alphanumeric characters. Remind the students to type the right code and make sure that they're joining your class, not other teachers'.



E. Why cannot the student see the assignment sent by their teacher?

Reasons:

- The student was not able to join the class before the assignment was sent.
 Ideally, students are required to join their teacher's class at the beginning of the school year, so they will not miss any activities in Quipper. But in case they forgot to join and an assignment was already sent, follow this procedure:
 - 1. Go to 'Class List'
 - 2. Search for the 'Class Name'
 - 3. Click 'View Details'

Q-Learn FAQs

A. What should the student do if their account is temporarily locked or they can't access it?

The student's account will be temporarily locked after multiple failed log-in attempts or forgot their account details. They should ask for help from the teachers or send a message to the official Quipper Facebook to reset their password. (See Q-Link FAQ-A)

B. What is SMN, and where can the student get one?

SMN stands for School Membership Number, which serves as the student's account license to join classes created by their teachers. This license marks that their accounts are paid/premium, and are only given to students of official partner schools of Quipper. Take note that each student is entitled to one SMN only and usually distributed during the orientation.



C. What is Class Code? How can the student get one?

Class code is a unique alphanumeric code with seven characters that let students join their teachers' classes on Q-Learn. Teachers should give the class codes before sending an assignment.

D. Why can't the student find their teacher's assignment, but they already joined the class?

The students might have joined the class past the deadline of the assignment. This would not reflect anymore on the student's end because the assignment has already expired. The student should ask their teacher to extend the deadline. If it's an exam, the teacher may opt to create a separate class exclusively for the student to join and



send the missed activity there for the student to answer.

E. Students answered the assignment correctly, but the system marked it as incorrect/There's wrong information on the study guide/video lesson. What to do?

Report the issue to the teacher or directly to Quipper support (either in person or through Facebook page) with complete details for verification:

- Subject;
- Grade Level;
- Unit no.;
- Topic Title;
- Question number/Study Guide page number/Time marker on video lesson;
- and Screenshots

Updates will be given as soon as possible. If the correction made aligns with the original answer of the student, the student's score will be updated automatically.

F. Students missed one of the teachers' assignments. Can he/she still answer it?

Yes, they can find the missed activities on the 'Overdue' section under 'To-Dos'. They may still answer this, but it's up to the teacher if he/she will consider and record the student's score.

G. May the students link their Quipper account to their Facebook account?

As much as Quipper has that feature available on Q-Learn, it highly discourages the students from linking their FB accounts to their Quipper accounts. This is to avoid losing their Quipper account should anything wrong happen to their FB accounts (e.g., hacked or forgotten details).

H. What can the students do with coins?

The Quipper product team is still developing useful features for coin usage. For now, teachers may use these coin systems for motivation/rewards purposes.
